



## Summer Theatre Workshop

### Teaching Artist

Studio Theatre Worcester seeks a passionate, dedicated, education-focused **Teaching Artist** for its inaugural Summer Theatre Workshop.

#### **The Program**

The Summer Theatre Workshop takes place at First Baptist Church in Worcester, MA July 12 – August 8, Monday through Friday from 8am-1:30pm, with programming running 8:45am-12:45pm. The Teaching Artist (working collaboratively with two Activity Leaders) will introduce our workshop attendees to character development and storytelling through movement techniques, games, crafts, and improvisation that will culminate in a live production of *The Jungle Book*. Performances take place August 6-8. Our Summer Theatre Workshop is focused on the attendee experience. We are much more concerned with the learning process and encouraging and developing individuals' skills and interests than in the presentation of the final product.

#### **The Position**

The Teaching Artist is a short-term, temporary, independent contractor position. We are looking for someone who has experience with young aspiring artists. The Teaching Artist will work in conjunction with two Activity Leaders to help facilitate the workshop and instruct enthusiastic, energetic school-aged children ages 8-14. Specifically, the Teaching Artist will set the overall vision for and direct the live production. The Teaching Artist will lead large group sessions, coordinate with the Technical Director, and generally ensure that the live production runs smoothly. As an independent contractor, the Teaching Artist has significant discretion in establishing the approach and methods to achieve these outcomes. The Teaching Artist contractor will receive a stipend. The stipend range is \$1500-\$2000 range, commensurate with experience. Please note that this is a small, local workshop and as such we are unable to offer additional fees or reimbursements. Candidates must be available for the entire workshop.
